Restrictions Extended - Continued Closure of SIGA Casinos

The Provincial Government has recently updated their COVID-19 closure measures. The current closure restrictions on casinos are to remain in place until **April 19th, 2021**. As such, all SIGA Casinos will continue to remain closed.

Employees will remain on their current leave: either paid leave, under the Canadian Emergency Wage Subsidy Program; or on an unpaid Public Health Emergency Leave, at which employees can access other federal benefit programs such as Employment Insurance or the Canada Recovery Benefit.

We understand that this is not the news that many of you wanted to hear. We are working to minimize any hardships created for you and our beneficiaries during our temporary closures and the HR Call Center remains open for assistance you may require.
