



STUDENT PROGRAMS ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Summer Student Eligibility Criteria:

- Students must be registered First Nation persons and must provide a copy of their treaty card.
- Students must be registered in a “full-time” post-secondary program.
- Students must be continuing students in year 2, 3 or 4.
- Students must provide recent transcripts.
- Students must provide class registration to prove they are a “continuing” student.
- Students must be able to obtain a certificate of registration with SLGA.

Practicum Student Eligibility Criteria:

- Students must be registered First Nation persons and must provide a copy of their treaty card.
 - Students must register in the work placement/practicum program at their educational institute.
 - Student’s education must align with the work placement/practicum education requirements.
 - Student must be able to obtain a certificate of registration with SLGA.
- * Student must be 19 years old.
- * SIGA employees (active or on a leave of absence) are NOT eligible to apply to the student programs.
